- v. Clinical Advisory Committee: intention is to have a joint committee from F/G. Taking applicants for this committee.

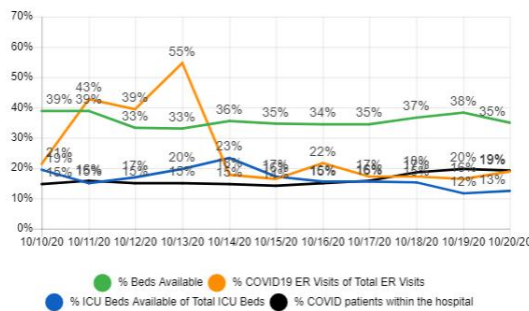
b. COVID:

- v. Severe cases are lower, with many cases able to be held in Med Surge

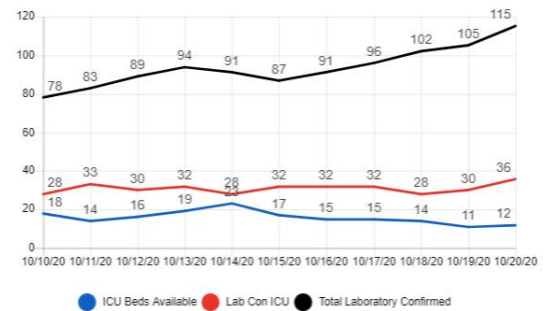

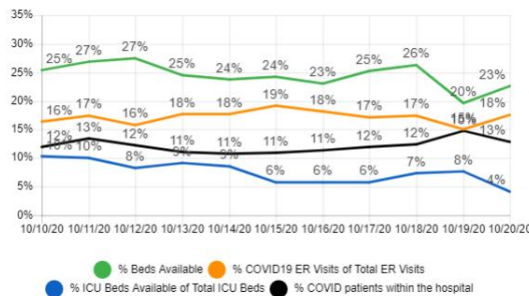
TSA F - Northeast TX RAC (Paris) - Percentages



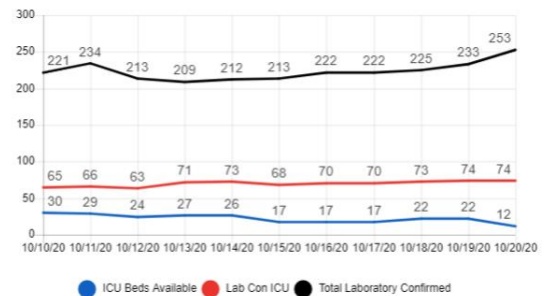
TSA F - Northeast TX RAC (Paris) - Counts
