 - Medical Education building Construction update and presentation by Rob Lamberson

Started September 27. A presentation with the view of construction as it relates to Helipads. Asked if flight crews could use higher elevation going over the construction trailer. Showed day and night pictures of the crane so crews would know what to look for. Shared policy and procedures for contractors. Some examples are calling dispatch at the start of the work day and the end of the work day. At the end of the day the crane will be in weathervane mode and is generally pointed to the south. Air crews asked to give a heads up preferably 10 minutes when they are in bound and out bound if possible. Drone Flight Rules presented. A second carne will be in place December - January. Both cranes will be down by September - October 2024. He will share the presentation with this group but ask group not to share.
