STROKE

1. Review data request form. What do we need to change, add, edit, etc.

The committee reviewed the Stroke RDC data request form created by Jennifer. No recommendations were made for edits, changes, etc. Jennifer stated that she would add a reference page as soon as she heard back from Allison Capetillo with AHA/ASA as to what all data can be retrieved from the RDC for RAC-G. Jennifer will get the form submitted to the RAC office as well as get filled out requesting data for the committee to start reviewing and creating PI projects around.

2. Discuss RDC Data (if available). Create 2-3 PI projects within the RAC to improve the metrics.

Jennifer is working with Loretta to get data. Loretta was to complete the RDC training last week, and she had requested the Stroke Committee create a data request form similar to what the Trauma Committee has created. This has been created and will be used moving forward for all data requests. The committee request that this be made available on the RAC-G website for all to have access to.

3. Stroke Prevention Day – January 25, 2025 – Want to do anything as a RAC for this? Focus is typically on AF and link to stroke risk.

The Committee would like to create something from a RAC level that can be utilized across the stroke and cardiac committee during our community events in January and February highlighting stroke risk associated with atrial fibrillation. Jennifer is going to create something and send to the RAC office to see if we can get created and branded by the RAC for all to distribute.

4. ZODIAC Trial – laying head flat in LVO patients – reached out to EMS to start incorporating into their CPGs – but think as a RAC worth discussing to adopt as well.

Discussion was had to create a subcommittee with members of the stroke committee along with members of prehospital to review the data/research and see if there is a protocol that can be created across the RAC-G for our stroke patients that are positive for a large vessel occlusion. Jennifer will lead creating the subcommittee. Katie Jones and Kala Anders have offered to be involved with this as well.

5. Nominations for Stroke Committee Chair

Any nominations to chair the stroke committee for the next cycle can be sent to Loretta. We will place her email in the chat box. Jennifer is willing to serve again as well. We will send out voting email at the beginning of next week so that we can move forward with this moving into 2025. It was also discussed if someone would be interested to learn the position to potentially chair in the future Jennifer is open to helping with that as well.

- Create Subcommittee to review ZODIAC Trial data and see if a protocol can be created within RAC-G
