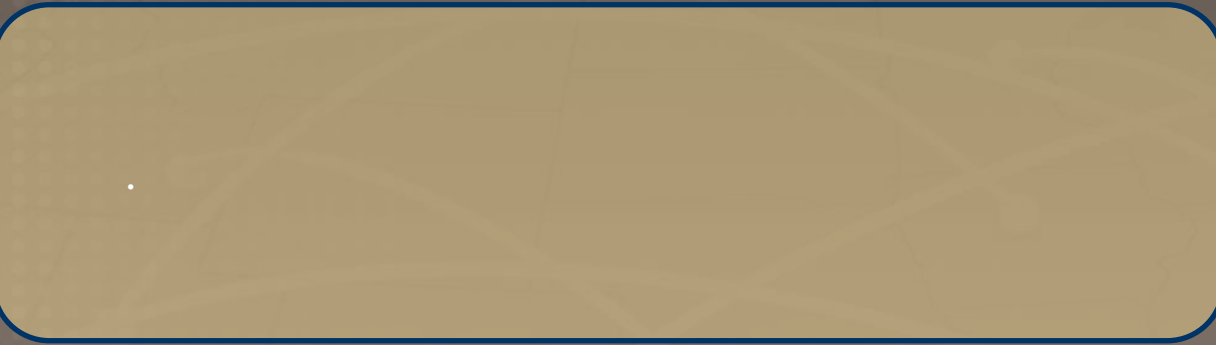

Responsibilities RAC G

Strategies:

3. Define data elements necessary to evaluate emergency healthcare system effectiveness.
4. Promote prevention education and timely access to definitive care and rehabilitation services.

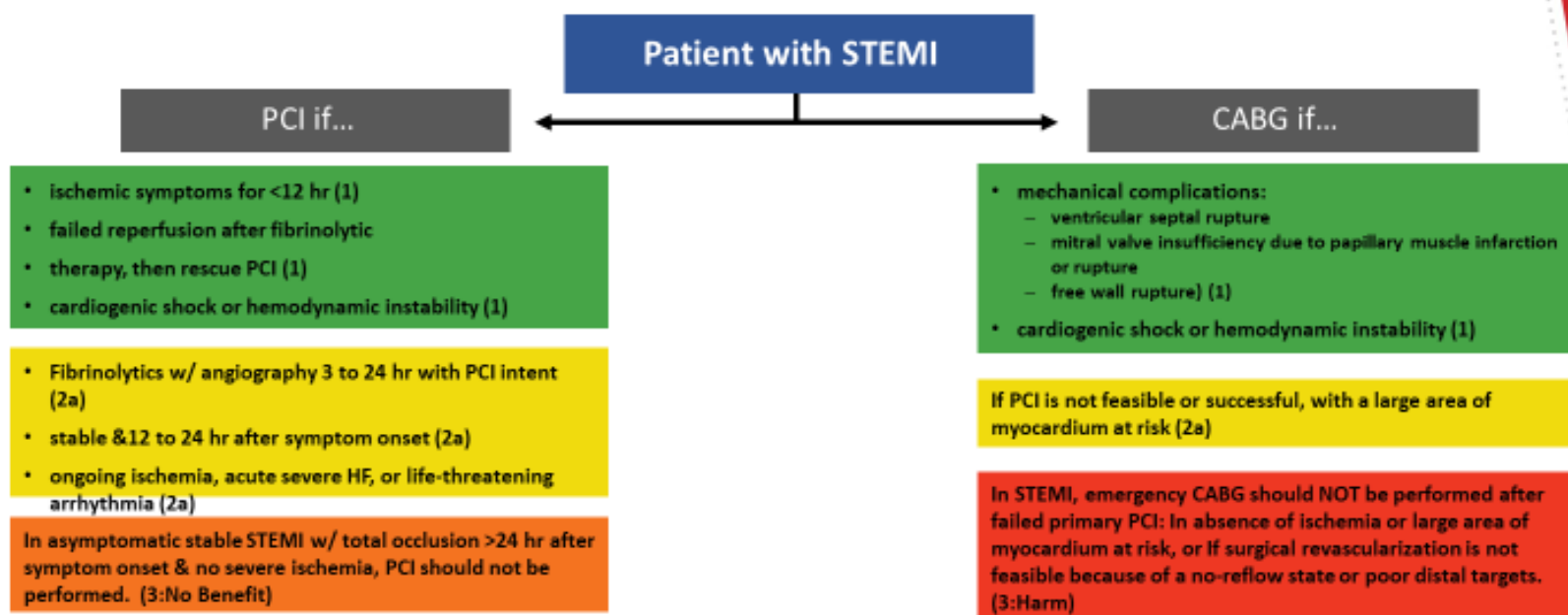
STEMI with Primary PCI

Prehospital Flight and EMS Criteria

- Prehospital 12 lead ECG <10 Minutes
- STEMI Alert to hospital <10 Minutes
- FMC to Balloon <90 Min
- FMC to Balloon <120 MIN if \geq 45 Min

Transport
